Released 4 years after being harvested. Our 2013 Reserve Cuvee is the perfect blend, balanced with complex fruit, and another of our wines that works perfectly with food. Big, rich, and complex - this wine will develop for many years in the bottle. Drink 2017 - 2025

Our lush blend of Estate Zinfandel, "Old Vine" Carignane, and Estate Petite Sirah – aged 26 months in 40% new oak barrels. Really a beautiful blend that we first made in 2006 and then in very limited quantity in 2008. Lush and smooth drinking says it all.

2013 Old Vine Carignane Dessert Wine – sold out 750ml

Our last dessert release and the second made from the lush Carignane grape - and it's simply over the top – rich, ripe plum, sweet concentration.

2012 Estate Toucanet – \$20 (now \$10) 375ml very limited

Terrie's Toucanet, our last estate dessert wine is 100% estate Zinfandel late harvested and fortified, rich & concentrated. Only one-half barrel produced, only available in 375ml bottles.

2010 Estate Toucanet – \$32 (now \$10) 500ml traditional bottles

Our 2010 Estate Toucanet is our third release of Toucanet, young, similar to our first Estate Toucanet in sweetness.

2009 Estate Toucanet – \$32 (now \$10) 500ml traditional bottles

Our 2009 Estate Toucanet is our second release of Toucanet, not overly sweet and has amazing flavors of ripe cherry.

TOUCAN WINES

Our outstanding 2012 vintage represents everything we hoped for when beginning this project back in the day. Every wine exceeds my expectation and each is now opening up beautifully. 2012 also represents our last year of "full" production. And the 2013 vintage closes the door on our project, in 2013 we again produced a balanced Reserve Cuvee blend that is ready for you to enjoy.

Our wines are limited and one of a kind. In 2017, we removed the Toucan Vineyard to allow for more personal time and freedom – as a result, these artisan estate wines will never be produced again. Buy them, savor them with food, and share them with family and friends.

OUR SHIPPING POLICY AND COSTS: In CA, NV, NM, and AZ we ship using the overnight services of Golden State Overnight, we charge a fixed cost of \$25 for each package shipped. This \$25 represents our cost and includes all shipping materials and fees.

We ship to other states as well, to those states we use UPS's standard ground delivery service. Once we process the shipping label for your shipments we'll notify you of the cost. We pass along our cost to ship with UPS without mark-up. Also includes shipping material.

If we determine that it's too hot to ship to your location, we'll notify you and hold the package for a more appropriate time.

Hand Crafted, Estate Grown, Limited Production Wines

Toucan Wines is a husband and wife run micro-winery and 3½ acre vineyard producing hand-crafted estate grown Zinfandel and Petite Sirah wines with a total limited estate production of about 300 cases.

Toucan Wines is located on the beautiful central coast of California, deep in the foothills of the Arroyo Grande Valley AVA. Our small 3½ acre hillside vineyard is planted to "old clone" head-trained Zinfandel and Petite Sirah vines known for low-yields, looser clusters and balanced fruit. Our micro-climate helps produce an elegant yet forward Zinfandel and Petite Sirah with rich varietal flavors and balanced acidity - making our wines the perfect selection for fine food. We produce every wine without adjustment, and each is carefully aged in only the finest new oak, then hand-bottled unfined and unfiltered.

Husband and wife, Doug Timewell and Terrie Leivers farm the vines and produce the wines, we truly are a family winery - we planted the vineyard, we perform the vineyard work, and we produce and bottle the wines in our winery located next to our family home. Small by any standard, micro-wineries like ours are focused on quality – it's our focus, attention to detail, and limited production that helps set our wines apart.
