## **Estate Grown, Produced & Bottled ~ Hand Crafted ~ Limited Production Wines**

Thank you for your interest in Toucan Wines. We're a central coast micro-winery and vineyard focused on our ultra-premium estate Zinfandel and Petite Sirah with a limited total production of about 400 cases.

We're located in southern most coastal region in San Luis Obispo County in the Arroyo Grande Valley AVA, on the beautiful Central Coast near the Huasna Valley. Our small 3½ - acre hillside vineyard is planted to "old clone" head-trained Zinfandel vines known for low-yields and balanced fruit. Grafted from the 1923 planting of the highly regarded Benito Dusi vineyard, our vines thrive in our micro-climate of warm-to-hot days and cool nights. Small by any standard, micro-winereries like ours are focused on quality – it's our limited production and focus that helps set our wines apart. We truly are a family run farm and winery, we planted the vines, we do the vineyard work, and we make the wines on-site.

### **2006 Toucan Wines Estate Zinfandel – only 123 cases produced**

Estate harvest began in small lots on September 30th and finally ended November 13th after several weeks of dry, warm and clear weather. Several days of cold soaking led to slow fermentation in small open bins and some lots were allowed extended maceration. Our small basket press performed a very gentle pressing and the wine placed in 80% new French, Hungarian, and American oak barrels and 20% in second year barrels for one year. Our 2006 Estate Zinfandel is a blend that includes 19% of our 2006 Estate Petite Sirah and proudly we bottled 123 cases of Estate Zinfandel unfinned and unfiltered. A separate bottling of 48 cases of the 2006 Estate Petite Sirah was also produced

The finished wine is deep-purple in color, with black-raspberry, brambly toasted-vanilla, and a candied-cherry nose, and tastes of rich ripened blackberry-cherry, blueberry & meaty tones – some would say Syrah like with medium tannins and balanced acids. The 2006 opens up to a rich and elegant wine with an endless nose. Drinking beautifully today, opening nicely in the glass, this wine will reward those who cellar wines.

### **2005 Toucan Wines Estate Zinfandel – awarded four gold medals – a few cases left**

Our total estate production of Zinfandel and Petite Sirah is included in this one bottling - no separate bottling of Petite Sirah was produced. A great year for our Estate Zinfandel! This wine is a deep garnet/purple, the nose is ripe, bright wild cherry and darker-berry fruit, spice and a forward elegance of fruit and oak; a big wine with tastes of intense black cherry, raspberry, blackberry, and slight pepper on a platform of refined oak, a full mouth feel and a long finish.

### **Estate Toucanet – Premier Release**

Our Estate Toucanet is the premier release of a wine produced from the desire to make an entirely estate based Porto-styled dessert wine. Produced from a blend of estate Zinfandel and Petite Sirah, three barrels from our 2007 vintage and one from our 2008 late harvested vintage, all of which have been fortified or Mutage with brandy spirits distilled from our 2006 Estate Zinfandel and aged for up to 22 months in fine oak.

### **2007 Toucan Wines Estate Petite Sirah (available 2010)**

Our total estate production of Estate Petite Sirah from this vintage is only 35 cases. Harvest of our Estate Petite Sirah occurred on September 29<sup>th</sup>. The fruit came into the winery in perfect condition and I allowed 3 plus days of cold soaking and a slow fermentation in one small open bin. After the first racking and a portion blended with the Estate Zinfandel, the remaining Petite Sirah was placed in new Hungarian oak and French oak barrels. Our 2007 Estate Petite Sirah was bottled on February 8<sup>th</sup> 2009 after 16 months in barrel. A bottling of 245 cases of our 2007 Estate Zinfandel was also bottled from our Toucan Wines estate vineyard – (available February, 2010).
